 presents constituted, and appointed for Executrix
 of this his last Will and testament, limited to his
 said Effects Stocks in the publick funds and other
 Chattels and Credits, and Administratrix of all
 such other goods and Credits Which at the time
 of his Death he shall or may have in the said
 Kingdom of Greatbrittain, or Which may any
 Ways belong to him in the said Kingdom, his
 beloved Wife Maria Margaretha Bosschaart
 giving unto her all such power and authoritij as
 can or may be given unto testamentarij Executrices
 in order immediately after the decease of him
 the ^{gent^m} Testator to cause all and singular the said Effects
 Stocks in the publick funds and other goods
 and Credits, Nothing excepted to be put and
 transferred upon the name or names of such
 person or persons as she shall think fitt, and
 further to manage, administer, sell, alienate,
 charge and incumber the same, and to receive the
 Moneys for the same, and there of to give acquittances

And he the said gent^l Testator desired that after
his decease a probate of this his Will and administration
of all and singular his Effects, Stocks, Chattels, and
Credits in the said Kingdom of Greatbrittain may
be granted unto his Executrix before named:
He the Testator requiring an act to be made hereof
by me Notary in form, as being his last Will
and Testament, relating to his Effects, Stocks,
Goods and Credits in the aforesaid Kingdom
of Greatbrittain
