


Gros 10 M. Regd. Appear'd before me Adriaan  
 Boerema Notary of the High Court of Justice  
 of Utrecht, residing at Utrecht, and by the  
 Honourable Magistrates of the same City admitt-  
 ed to the exercise of the said Office in presence  
 of the witnessess inter written the Hono-  
 rable Dr. Thomas Adriaan Boddaert Doctor  
 in Law dwelling in this City, before to me  
 Notary, who considering the frailty of Human  
 life, and having certain goods, Chattels and  
 Credit in England, videlicet to have made,  
 retained, constituted and appointed, as he doth  
 make or leave Constitute and appoint by these  
 Presents his Dear wife Madam Wilhelmina  
 Lucia van Alphen, his Executrix, giving and  
 granting unto her all such power and auth-  
 ority as to an Executrix and Administratrix  
 can or may be given, for immediately after  
 his decease to ask and take Letters of Adminis-  
 tration, for all the Goods, Chattels and Ex-  
 credits, which he after his Decease shall or may  
 have in England, standing in his own name  
 Separately or jointly with any Person and per-  
 sons whatsoever, to be given, and granted by the  
 judges of the prerogative Court of Edinburgh  
 or by their lawfull Surrogates, or by any

other Competent Ecclesiastical Judge whatsoever,  
that they the said Madam Wilhelmina Lucia  
van Alphen may Devise, to Devise, sell  
assign and transfer all his said Goods, Chattels  
and Credits, and he doth likewise make certain  
constitute and appoint his said Councillor, for  
after having obtained the said Letters of Attri-  
bution, to sell assign and transfer for any  
consideration sum or sums whatsoever, unto  
him self, or any other person or persons whatsoever,  
all and every the said Goods, Chattels and Credits  
or any part or share thereof, as also to receive  
the consideration money thereof, and to sign,  
Seal and Deliver good and sufficient acquittan-  
ces and Discharges for the same, with powers  
unto her to substitute one or more Attorneys in  
her stead and place, and again at her pleasure  
to revoke the same, All the aforesaid he Appen-  
did declare to be his Last will, In witness where-  
of the aforesd Honorable Thomas Adriani  
Boddens hath hereunto set his hand and seal  
in Astrecht this 24th Day of August 1766 Sixty-  
Two.
